



Annual Vegetation Treatment Areas (7)

Complete prior to bushfire danger period.
Zone depths are based on tree type vegetation.
Zones can be altered annually to better suit overall fuel /
vegetation management.

1. Remove all dead or diseased vegetation.
2. Under scrub zone area and remove cut material.
3. Grasses to remain but trimmed to not higher than 100mm.
4. Selectively remove continuously linked tree crowns by creating 5-10m gaps. Leave stumps in ground for soil stabilisation.
5. Remove all cut vegetation to green waste tip or location outside Fire Management Zone.
6. Where possible allow animal grazing to support Zone.

Regular Inner Protection Zone (IPA) Treatments

1. Regularly mow or slash IPA (30m & 20m widths)
2. Prune trees and bushes minimum 1.0m clear of all glazed surfaces. (doors and windows)
3. Remove all tree branches overhanging buildings.
4. Ensure readiness prior to bushfire danger period.

Conduct all works to the 'Standards for Asset Protections Zones' as prepared by the ACT RFS.
