I am writing with regard to information posted at <u>Parking fees | Services (anu.edu.au)</u>, suggesting a more advanced level of conversation than is represented under the title "Future Parking and Public Transport Improvements" in particular:

"The final piece of ongoing work is the implementation of a bus service. Transport Canberra is supportive of a bus route. They are preparing a feasibility report to acquire and resource two electric buses to solely serve the ANU campus from the city main bus interchange. There is no confirmed start date for the service, but it is aimed to be up and running in 2025."

Whilst I agree that there is a shared interest in progressing together, with Transport Canberra providing advice, we are unable to confirm anything other than assistance in planning, rather than the suggested provision of a bus service for ANU. I would prefer that the following be more appropriate to convey the level of conversation at this stage:

"The final piece of ongoing work is the implementation of a bus service. Transport Canberra is supportive of working with the ANU to resolve campus transport concerns where it can, and are working with the ANU on potential options that can support the ANU to, for example, acquire and operate a bus service for the ANU campus and connecting with wider public transport services (e.g. connect to the City Bus Interchange. There is no confirmed start date for the service, but engagement is progressing."

I am happy to continue discussion but would ask confirmation that this amendment has been made to correct the position in the first instance.
