



MICHAEL HARGRAVE PRIZE FOR OPHTHALMOLOGY

Conditions of Award

1. INTRODUCTION AND RECOGNITION

Each year the School of Medicine and Psychology may offer a prize known as the Michael Hargrave Prize for Ophthalmology.

The objective of the prize is to recognise exemplary achievement in Ophthalmology for students currently enrolled in Year Four of the Doctor of Medicine and Surgery (MChD).

The value of the prize/s awarded is \$500

The prize will be on offer from 2024 to 2027

Funding for this prize has been provided by Dr David Dickson a retired ophthalmologist who was previously a VMO at Canberra and North Canberra Hospitals and named after a former mentor.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The award is available each year to an ANU student who is:

- a. a domestic or international student.
- b. enrolled in Year 4 of the Doctor of Medicine and Surgery (MChD) program in the School of Medicine and Psychology
- c. achieved a grade of CRS or higher for their Year 4 course
- d. attended their assigned Ophthalmology clinic
- e. attended the "Hands on Eyes" workshop
- f. obtained the highest mark in the multi-choice ophthalmology quiz

3. SELECTION AND CONSTRAINTS

A selection committee nominated by Associate Director Educations (Medicine) and including the Lead Academic in Ophthalmology in the School of Medicine and Psychology will review all students meeting the above eligibility criteria. The committee will recommend a winner to the Director, School of Medicine and Psychology.

The Selection committee reserves the right to make no award if it considers there is no applicant of sufficient merit. The prize will not be shared. In the event of 2 or more students meeting the eligibility criteria the prize will be awarded to the student with the highest result from any end-of-semester summative assessment in Ophthalmology.

Any student who is making a second or subsequent attempt at any of the courses in the MChD program, or has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which, is in the opinion of the selection committee, substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded will not be eligible for the prize

4. RECIPIENT OBLIGATIONS

The awarding of a prize is based on the information provided to the University. A prize may be declined by the recipient once they have been notified as the prize winner. This must be provided in writing to the School of Medicine and Psychology no later than 30 days from notification.

If the prize is accepted by the recipient, they agree to the Publication of their name.

In some instances the recipient may be asked to:

- 1) write a letter of thanks to the donor;
- 2) participate in marketing activities and/or asked to provide a reflective statement.

5. REVIEW OF PRIZE

The award will be reviewed:

- a. at the conclusion of the period outlined in section 1; or
- b. if any eligibility requirements are to be amended
- c. after 3 years

whichever is earliest.

6. VARIATION TO CONDITIONS OF AWARD

In exceptional circumstances and on a case-by-case basis, these conditions of award may be varied by the Director, School of Medicine and Psychology on the recommendation of the Selection Committee
