PART 5 - ACCREDITATION ITEMS

*Item 26 Amendment of a Graduate Award – B Music

Professor Bronwyn Parry, Dean of ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences (CASS) and Professor Samantha Bennett, Deputy Head of School, School of Music, presented to Items 26 and 28 - both related to the Bachelor of Music. Prior to the meeting Academic Board members were provided correspondence from the specified staff from the School of Music, a student and a representative from the National Tertiary Education Union (NTEU).

Dr Flaherty presented a request to defer consideration of the amendment to the Bachelor of Music and the associated undergraduate sub-plans until after release of the CASS Implementation Plan, along with an additional request for CASS to undertake further consultation on the proposed changes, including market research across prospective students and benchmarking. Although this is not directly related to the ANU Renew program, the creation of new courses has implications on workload. New information was provided at this meeting, including two of the three letters referenced.

Professor Parry and Professor Bennet provided detailed information on the extensive consultation process on the proposed changes, which commenced approximately two years ago and has involved significant international benchmarking to ensure best practice. The program review has reflected a data informed process with consultation methodology including staff strategic planning days, working groups, governance committees, and executive review. The proposed amendments reflect the modernisation and shift in the discipline, the shift in the student cohort, and opens the program to increased flexibility. The amendments are purely pedagogical and should not be conflated with ANU Renew. It was also confirmed that current students will not be affected by the program revisions.

There was significant discussion around the program, courses, governance requirements and assurance that the differing viewpoints were heard. Key points included:

- Canvassing of future students has been undertaken at open days.
- There is a time dependency for approval of the changes as first round offers are made from 4 September 2025. All program and course information must be available to future students.
- The scope of change is not significantly different to other program reviews.
- It was reiterated that the amendments are purely pedagogical. The program includes the
 opportunity for students to engage with performance in different ways and modalities and that the
 integration of performance and composition will provide increased academic rigour, increased
 flexibility and will ensure the school can be benchmarked against international schools of music.
- It was noted that as a University we are required to review and revise how our pedagogy is delivered in all our programs to ensure we perform to the highest standards and practices.
- The amendments are in alignment with the external review undertaken in 2023.

Outcome

- Due to differing perspectives the Chair, Academic Board determined a vote would be required.
 Nine members were in favour of postponing consideration of Items 26 and 28, with 25 in favour of considering the recommended resolutions.
- In response to a query regarding revising the accreditation date to an earlier time period, Professor Parry advised the Academic Board that this is not necessary as the program and courses will undergo continuous review in between being accredited and the request for reaccreditation, and that is in the best interest of the school.
