

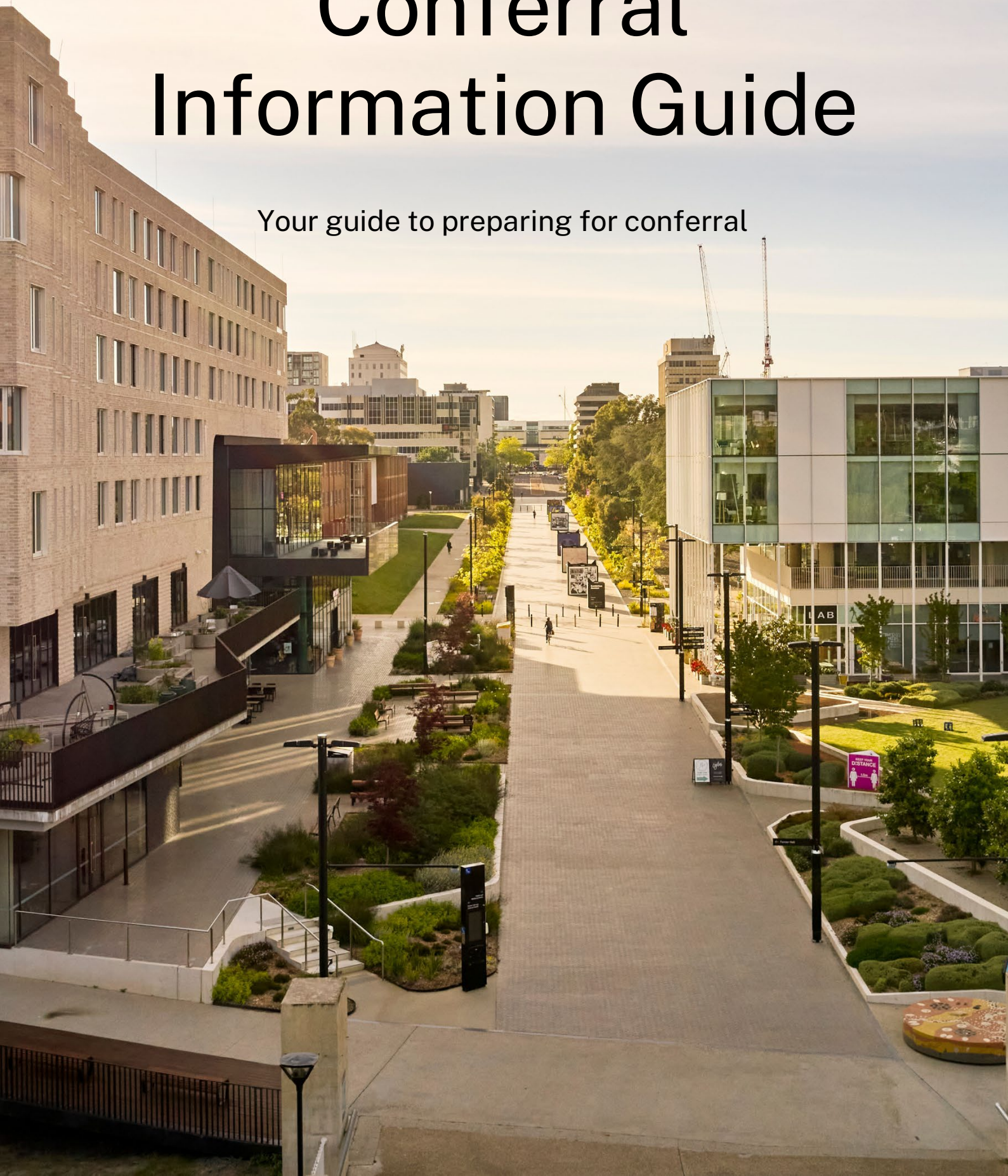

Conferral Information Guide

Your guide to preparing for conferral



Congratulations on your upcoming conferral

You have received this guide because you have been identified as 'Approved' or 'Conditionally Approved' (pending your final semester results) to have your Award(s) conferred in July 2026.

If you have completed all academic requirements by the end of Semester 1 2026, and have actioned all obligations to the University, your Award(s) will be automatically conferred on:



28 July 2026



What do I need to do?

To ensure a smooth conferral process you must have completed all outstanding tasks by the specified deadlines (see page 3):

- Settle any outstanding charges (e.g. library, accommodation, tuition, parking) by **Thursday 25 June 2026**.
- Complete any outstanding tasks on ANUHub (e.g. exam ID verification, USI verification, RRR (Rights, Relationships and Respect) training module) by **Thursday 25 June 2026**.
- Verify and update your personal details on ANUHub by **Friday 3 July 2026**.
- Students who complete their academic requirements and are not enrolled in further studies at ANU will lose their active student status. This may impact access to certain University services and systems such as University email. Ensure you download and save any necessary documents or information from your ANU accounts by **28 July 2026**.

What if I want to defer my conferral?

If you **do not** wish to have your Award(s) conferred in July 2026, you will need to submit a 'defer' response on ANUHub (see page 6).

You do not need to take any action if you would like your Award(s) to be conferred in July.

2027 Graduation Ceremony

All students conferred in July will receive an invitation to attend their 2027 graduation ceremony via their Alumni email account closer to the ceremony date. Details of the 2027 graduation ceremonies will be published on the [ANU website](#) once they are finalised.

Verify and update personal details in ANUHub

- Ensure your full name (including any middle name) is correctly recorded in ANUHub, as this is how it will appear on your Testamur(s).
- If your name is incorrectly reflected, you must submit a [Change of Name form](#) to student@anu.edu.au by **Friday 3 July 2026**. You must also ensure that you have revised your [Unique Student Identifier \(USI\)](#) account to reflect your full name.
- Update your mailing address and contact number in ANUHub to receive your conferral documents without delay. International mailing addresses will require an international contact number.
- To update your mailing address or phone number in ANUHub, click the "Personal Data" tile on the homepage, then "Profile" and follow the prompts to amend your mailing address and/or phone number. This page can also be found via the pathway:

Settle outstanding obligations to The University

To ensure your Award(s) are conferred on 28 July 2026, it is essential to clear any outstanding obligations with ANU by 25 June 2026. This includes completing the RRR (Rights, Relationships and Respect) training module, providing your valid Unique Student Identifier (USI), and settling any outstanding tuition fees, library fines, accommodation charges, or any other debts.

If these obligations are not actioned by the deadline, you **will not be eligible** for conferral, and your conferral documents such as your Testamur(s), Academic Transcript, and Australian Higher Education Graduation Statement (AHEGS), will not be issued.

Check your conferral details in ANUHub.

Step 1: Log in to your ANUHub account [here](#).

Step 2: Click on the NavBar button at the top right-hand corner of the page.

Step 3: Click on Menu.

Step 4: Scroll down and click on ANUHub.

Step 5: Click on Graduation.

There will be two headings under the 'Graduation' menu:

Graduation Details: Where you can view your current eligibility status, the date of your conferral, the degree(s), certificate(s) and/or diploma(s) to be awarded and the name that will appear on the Testamur.

Graduation Invitation: Where you can respond ONLY if you wish to defer your conferral. Check your final eligibility status on the Graduation Details tab within ANUHub after:

9am on 17 July



Receiving your conferral documents (digital and physical)

Digital documents

- Digital copies of your Testamur(s), Academic Transcript and Australian Higher Education Graduate Statement (AHEGS) will be available via [My eEquals](#). You will receive an email notification when they can be viewed (no later than 72 hours after your conferral).

In-person collection

- If you would prefer to collect your Testamur(s) in-person from ANU campus, this option will be available on:

30-31 July 2026, Lowitja O'Donoghue Cultural Centre Drama Theatre

- To arrange in-person collection, complete the [online form](#) by **Friday, 3 July 2026** so we can prepare your Testamur(s) for collection.
- A valid physical Photo ID will be required upon collection for verification purposes. This must be either government issued or your ANU Student Card.
- Please note: if you do not opt-in for in-person collection, or if you do not collect your Testamur(s) by 5pm on 31 July 2026, your Testamur(s) will be sent to you by mail, which remains the default method of delivery.

Third party collection

- If you wish to authorise another person to collect your Testamur(s) on your behalf, you will need to email graduation.officer@anu.edu.au from your ANU email account by 3 July 2026, outlining the full name of the individual collecting your Testamur(s). Please note the individual nominated will have to provide physical photo ID at the time of collection or the Testamur(s) will not be released.

Mailing of Testamur(s)

- Complete the [online form](#) to confirm your nominated mailing address. Please remember that this must match the address listed in your ANUHub account.
- You can expect to receive the Testamur(s) within 8 weeks from your conferral date.
- You will receive an email notification from DHL Express once your Testamur(s) have been collected for shipping. This email will include your tracking number so you can monitor the delivery progress.
- Please do not provide a PO BOX address, as DHL Express requires a physical delivery address.

To defer conferral, respond in ANUHub

Please complete the following by Friday 3 July 2026

Conferral of Award(s) will be automatic in July.

If you do not wish to have your Award(s) conferred in July 2026 then you will need to submit a 'defer' response on ANUHub.

This will postpone your conferral to a future session, either 6 or 12 months later, depending on your selection. Please note that the maximum period for which you can defer your conferral is 12 months, meaning the latest available conferral date for you is July 2027.

Important

If you submit a 'defer' response on ANUHub, your Award(s) will not be conferred. An individual is not officially recognised as an ANU graduate and will not receive their Testamur(s), Academic Transcript or AHEGS until they have conferred their Award(s).

Submitting a 'defer' response in ANUHub

Navigate to the 'Graduation Invitation' page on ANUHub (see page 4). On this page, select 'defer'.

Note: ONLY select this option if you do **not** wish to confer your Award(s) now.
