The ANU Union Inc. in partnership with the ANUSA Welfare Officer and the ANU Health Services team established a food aid program in March 2013 to provide free evening meals to students of the above services who were deemed in need of short term assistance.

Eligibility is assessed by the service providers responding to a specific client need in relation to a life event of a financial, emotional, physical or mental health issue. Recipients are offered a free evening meal for as long as deemed necessary. Meals are provided fresh daily with a number of frozen meals kept in stock to meet peak supply needs as required. The meals are distributed by ANUSA and prepared by the chefs at the ANU Union Inc.

Even though the Union has done its best to do basic maintenance of the venue, necessary upkeep such as a coat of paint, new furniture etc has been way overdue.
