Thanks for meeting with me today!

Just summarising the productive discussion we had today about the lockout fee. We agreed that while it is an issue that has different prioritisation for the two of us, you would review it after three months of operation (May to June).

You also mentioned that there were some local provisions that were being developed... something involving borrowing a card and only being charged if you don't give it back within 24 hours. You mentioned that you didn't have the details to hand. Maybe you might be able to update on that when you next meet so she can message to the individual presidents what they can expect in their communities or otherwise how they can get an understanding from their Heads or RLMs about what will be available.

I will send another email at a later point regarding my priorities for the year as we discussed.
