Elite Athlete Adjustment Factor Application

Please read these notes before completing the form

Who should apply?

This application form is to be completed by domestic undergraduate applicants whose education has been affected by elite level competing and training commitments during study relevant for entry to the Australian National University (ANU). To be considered for Elite Athlete adjustments you must:

- - Be a domestic applicant completing either an Australian Year 12 or the International Baccalaureate in Australia;
 - Have an ATAR or equivalent at or above 70;
 - · Be applying for an eligible Bachelor degree.

Elite Athlete adjustments may only be applied to ANU Bachelor degree programs with a selection rank requirement between 80.00-98.00. An adjustment of 5 points may be awarded to eligible applicants, in accordance with the approved schedule. If you are successful for both a National Access Scheme adjustment and an Elite Athlete adjustment, no more than 15 points may be awarded towards your selection rank. When to apply?

You should return this application form to the Access and Inclusion office as soon as possible after the submission of your application for admission. Applications for Elite Athlete Adjustment Factors will not be accepted after the closing date for admissions applications.

What else do you need to know?

You must include supporting documents that substantiate your claims and provides evidence of your capacity to succeed. This needs to include the following:

- · A statement outlining your sporting commitments during Year 11 and 12 and how they impacted on your final Year 12 results. Your statement must include your full name and application number.
- A statement from your coach or national sporting institute that you are considered to be an elite athlete and recognised to be a member under one of the Elite Athlete adjustment factor schedule categories.
- · A letter from your school office in support of your application that corroborates the impact on your schooling is recommended.

If successful, you will be provided 5 points to your selection rank for eligible ANU preferences.

Appeals

If you are dissatisfied with the decision regarding your application, you may seek a review by the Associate Dean or nominee within 20 working days.

The request must be lodged in writing with the Dean of the relevant College for Coursework Award students within 20 working days of your being informed of the Associate Dean or nominee's decision.

Appeal provisions for admissions are drawn from the Coursework Awards Rule and Research Awards Rule.
