

THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF ASIA AND THE PACIFIC A J R YENCKEN PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of \$500 for award each year which shall be known as the A J R Yencken Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year:
 - (i) was enrolled in a program leading to the award of a degree of Bachelor in the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific; and
 - (ii) achieved the best result as shown by the award of the highest mark for the thesis component undertaken as part of any of the Honours courses offered by the College.
- 3. The prize shall not be shared.
- 4. If, in any year, two or more students achieve the same top mark, the students' previous academic record will be taken into consideration to determine an outright winner of the prize.
- 5. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, justify awarding the prize, the prize shall not be awarded for that year.
