**HELEN HUGHES 1st MASTER YEAR DEGREE PRIZE IN INTERNATIONAL
AND DEVELOPMENT ECONOMICS**

Conditions of Award

1. There shall be a prize of \$400 for award each graduating class (generally each semester) which shall be known as the Helen Hughes 1st Year Master Degree Prize in International and Development Economics.
2. The prize shall be awarded to the student in that year, who:
 - (i) completed the 48 unit initial component for the award of the Master of International and Development Economics or the Master of Environmental and Resource Economics;
 - (ii) in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, achieved the best overall aggregate results in these programs.
3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if:
 - (i) the student has made a second or subsequent attempt at any course in the Master degree; or
 - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which is, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
4. If, in any graduating class, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded for that graduating class shall be divided equally between them.
5. If, in any graduating class, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, justify the award of the prize, the prize shall not be awarded.
6. In the case where the prize is awarded for the Graduate Diploma in Environmental and Resource Economics, the prize shall be known as the Helen Hughes Graduate Diploma Prize in Environmental and Resource Economics.
