STEVEN KLIMIDIS MEMORIAL PRIZE IN CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

Conditions of Award

- 1. The Steven Klimidis Memorial Prize in Clinical Psychology is valued at \$2,500 and will be available for award each calendar year to a higher degree research student.
- 2. An eligible student will be a higher degree research student at the Research School of Psychology who is enrolled in either the Doctor of Philosophy degree program in clinical psychology or the Doctor of Psychology (Clinical) who:
 - has, at the time of selection for the prize, completed all of the required milestones (annual progress reports, mid-term review);
 - (ii) is in the third or fourth year of their higher degree research study;
 - (iii) has completed, with high and consistent achievement, the coursework and clinical placement components undertaken as part of the degree program for the degree in clinical psychology; and
 - (iv) has published or has had accepted for publication in final form, a scholarly paper based on results of research which will be reported in the doctoral thesis in clinical psychology.
- 3. The membership of the Selection Committee will be determined from time to time and the Selection Committee will be chaired by the Director, Research School of Psychology (or nominee).
- 4. Nominees will be considered by the Selection Committee and the prize winner will be recommended to the Director of Science Education for approval.
- 5. If, in any year, the Selection Committee recommends that there is more than one eligible student, the prize, in that year, may be shared between a maximum of two.
- 6. If, in any year, the Selection Committee recommends that no student meets the requirements for the award of the prize, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
- 7. A successful prize winner may not be awarded the prize more than once.
