THERAPEUTIC GUIDELINES LIMITED PHARMACOLOGY PRIZE CONDITIONS OF AWARD

1. INTRODUCTION AND RECOGNITION

Each year from 2022-2024 inclusive, the School of Medicine and Psychology may offer a prize known as the Therapeutic Guidelines Year 4 Pharmacology Prize.

The value of the prize awarded is \$500.

Funding for this prize has been generously provided by Therapeutic Guidelines Limited in order to honour outstanding achievement in Pharmacology.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The award is available each year to an ANU student who is:

- (a) a domestic or international student;
- (b) enrolled in Year 4 of the MChD program at the ANU College of Health and Medicine;
- (c) shortlisted in the top 25 students in Pharmacology assessment during Phase 2 (Year 3 & Year 4); AND
- (d) has successfully passed all components (including Professional Practice) of Phase 2 (Year 3 and 4) without having repeated a year.

SELECTION AND CONSTRAINTS

Selection is made in consultation with the lead Pharmacology academic based on the student having contributed meaningfully to Pharmacology teaching during Phase 2 and have shown exceptional interest, aptitude and commitment to Pharmacology.

The prize shall not be shared.

Where required, the ANU Medals Committee will be available for qualitative or subjective assessment determinants if a decision is not reached within the College to determine prize winners.

3. RECIPIENT OBLIGATIONS

The awarding of a prize is based on the information provided to the University. A prize may be declined by the recipient once they have been notified as the prize winner. This must be provided in writing to School of Medicine and Psychology no later than 30 days from notification.

If the prize is accepted by the recipient, they agree to the Publication of their name.

In some instances the recipient may be asked to:

- 1) write a letter of thanks to the donor;
- 2) participate in marketing activities and/or asked to provide a reflective statement.

4. REVIEW OF PRIZE

The award will be reviewed:

- (a) at the conclusion of the period outlined in section 1; or
- (b) if any eligibility requirements are to be amended
- (c) after 3 years

whichever is earliest.

5. VARIATION TO CONDITIONS OF AWARD

In exceptional circumstances and on a case-by-case basis, these conditions of award may be varied by the Director of the School of Medicine and Psychology on the recommendation of the Professor of Medicine.
