ANU MEDICAL SCHOOL ANATOMY DISSECTION PRIZE

- 1. There shall be a prize for award by Council each year that shall be known as the ANU Medical School Anatomy Dissection Prize.
- 2. The value of the prize is \$A200 sponsored by the Medical School.
- 3. The prize is for award each year to the students who, in that year:
 - (i) were enrolled in the Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery Program;
 - (ii) had completed the best dissection in the Anatomy Dissection Option Program in Block 7, Year 2.
- 4. The award of prize will be judged by the Professor of Anatomy, on the merits of:
 - attendance during option
 - degree of difficulty of dissection
 - · the outcome of the dissection
 - the presentation of dissection work
- 5. The prize may be shared.
- 6. In any year, the Professor of Anatomy may recommend to the Dean of the Medical School, that no student merits the award of the prize in that year.

The ANU Medical School has instituted this Prize in order to acknowledge the best dissected specimen in the Anatomy Dissection Option Program. Such a Prize encourages the development of surgical skills, together with the appreciation of different body part relationships and textures.
