

THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF ASIA AND THE PACIFIC AUSTRALIA INDONESIA ASSOCIATION PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of \$350 for award each year which shall be known as the Australia Indonesia Association Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year:
 - (i) was enrolled in a program leading to the award of the degree of Bachelor in the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific; and
 - (ii) achieved the best overall average mark for courses taken in third year Indonesian.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize in any year if:
 - (i) the student is making a second or subsequent attempt at any of the courses; or
 - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which, is in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, substantially similar to the content any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 4. If, in any year, two or more students achieve the same top average mark, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific justify awarding the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
