

THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SOCIAL SCIENCES BASIL BRESSLER PRIZE FOR VIOLIN

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of a Leandro Bisiach 1912 violin, two bows and a carry case on loan for one year for award each year which shall be known as the Basil Bressler Prize for Violin.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year:
 - (i) was enrolled in a program leading towards the award of a degree in the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences;
 - (ii) was enrolled Performance Major in Violin within the ANU School of Music;
 - (iii) displayed outstanding progress and potential within that major; and
 - (iv) was in need of an excellent instrument.
- 3. In any year, there shall only be one winner.
- 4. A student may be awarded the prize on more then one occasion.
- 5. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences justify awarding the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
