DAMIAN McMAHON CLINICAL SKILLS PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of \$1,000 for award each year which shall be known as the Damian McMahon Clinical Skills Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who:
 - (i) in that year was enrolled in Year Four of the Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery Program in the ANU College of Medicine, Biology and the Environment;
 - (ii) was the best performing student in Phase 2 clinical skills assessments as advised by the Medical Education Unit, based on results of Phase 2 Observed Structured Clinical Examinations and the Year Four Long Case examinations; and
 - (iii) received a grade of CRS or higher in all courses in Years One to Four on first attempt.
- 3. The Dean of Medicine and Health Sciences shall appoint the Selection Committee which shall include the Deputy Dean of the Medical School (or nominee), Chair of the Clinical Skills Theme (or nominee), and the Clinical Skills Manager.
- 4. The prize shall not be shared.
- 5. In the event of a tie, the students' score for their Phase 1 clinical skills results will be taken into consideration by the Selection Committee.
- 6. If, in any year, no student is assessed, in the opinion of the Dean of Medicine and Health Sciences, as justifying the award of the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
