

THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SOCIAL SCIENCES DANTE ALIGHIERI SOCIETY PRIZE FOR INTRODUCTORY ITALIAN Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of \$100 for award by Council each year which shall be known as the Dante Alighieri Prize for Introductory Italian
- 2. The prize shall be awarded each year to the student who in that year:
 - (a) was enrolled in a program leading to the award of the degree of Bachelor;
 - (b) achieved the best results in the courses ITAL1002 Italian Studies Introductory 1 and ITAL1003 Italian Studies Introductory 2 with Distinction or High Distinction.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if the student is making a second or subsequent attempt at the courses.
- 4. If, in any year, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Council, justify awarding the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
