DAVID EDWARDS MEMORIAL PRIZE IN GEOGRAPHY

Conditions of Award

1. There shall be a prize of \$350 for award each year which shall be known as the David Edwards Memorial Prize in Geography.
2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year, was enrolled in a program leading to the award of a degree of Bachelor.
3. The prize shall be awarded for the highest aggregate mark in the courses Environment and Society: Geography of Sustainability (ENVS1001) and Sustainable Development (ENVS1008). At least one of the two courses must have been taken in the year of the award of the prize.
4. If either of the courses set out above cease to be offered, the prize shall be awarded in respect of another course, offered by the College, the content of which is similar to the content of the originally named course.
5. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if:
 - (i.) the student has been enrolled or is enrolled for a second time in either of the nominated courses; or
 - (ii.) the student has previously pursued a program of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or any other tertiary education institution) the content of which is, in the opinion of the Associate Dean (Education), substantially similar to the content of the nominated course.
6. If, in any year, two or more students achieve the same aggregate mark, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
7. If, in any year, no candidate achieves results that, in the opinion of the Associate Dean (Education), justify the award of the prize, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
