ELSPETH YOUNG PRIZE FOR SOCIAL CONTRIBUTION

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of \$80 for award each graduating class (generally each semester), which shall be known as the Elspeth Young Prize for Social Contribution.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that graduating class:
 - (i) successfully completed the requirements for admission to the degree of Master of Environmental Management and Development; and
 - (ii) in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, made the most valuable contribution to the social fabric of the Environment and Development Program student group.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if:
 - (i) the student has made a second or subsequent attempt at any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded; or
 - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which is, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 4. If, in any graduating class, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded for that graduating class shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any graduating class, no student makes a contribution that, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, justifies the award of the prize, the prize shall not be awarded.
