GARNAUT PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of a \$100 awarded in respect of each graduating class (generally each semester), which shall be known as the Garnaut Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that graduating class:
 - (i) successfully completed the requirements for admission to the degree of Master of Climate Change; and
 - (ii) achieved the best overall aggregate result in the program.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if:
 - (i) the student has made a second or subsequent attempt at any of the courses; or
 - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution) the content of which is, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific and the Dean of Science, substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 4. If, in any graduating class, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded in that graduating class shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any graduating class, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific and the Dean of Science, justify awarding the prize, the prize shall not be awarded.
