GENDER AND MEDICINE ESSAY YEAR THREE PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize for award each year which shall be known as the Gender and Medicine Essay Year Three Prize.
- 2. The value of the prize is \$500.
- 3. The prize is for award each year to the student who in that year:
 - (i) was enrolled in Year Three of the Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery Program; and
 - (ii) has submitted, by the due date, a piece of work related to Women's and/or Children's Health submitted as part of the Gender and Medicine portfolio which is judged to be the most outstanding by the Selection Committee. The piece of work will reflect a detailed understanding of the implications of the topic for women's and children's health.
- 4. The piece of work should be at least 1000 words long.
- 5. Each year the due date for the project will be promulgated on the Medical School online learning system.
- 6. The prize will be determined by the Dean as acting on the advice of a Selection Committee drawn from members of the Medical Women's Society of ACT and Region.
- 7. The prize may be shared.
- 8. If, in any year, no submitted piece of work is assessed by the Dean of Medicine and Health Sciences acting on the advice of the Selection Committee, as sufficiently outstanding and reflecting comprehensive understanding of the importance of women's and children's health, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
