GEORGE ZUBRZYCKI PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of \$400 for award by Council every second year which shall be known as the George Zubrzycki Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded every second year to the student who in that (or the previous) year:
 - (i) was enrolled in Sociology IV (H) (or Sociology IV (H) combined with Honours in any other ANU College); and
 - (ii) achieved the best result in that (or the previous) year as shown by the award of the highest mark.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize in any year if:
 - (i) the student is making a second or subsequent attempt at the course; or
 - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a program, course or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which, is in the opinion of the Dean of the College of Arts and Social Sciences, substantially similar to the content of the course for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 4. If, in any year, two or more students achieve the same top mark, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Council justify awarding the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
