

**THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
MEDICAL SCHOOL
GRAHAM WILKINSON PRIZE
Conditions of Award**

1. There shall be a prize for award each year which shall be known as the ANU Medical School Graham Wilkinson Prize.
2. The value of the prize is \$1000.
3. The prize shall be awarded each year to the student who, in that year:
 - (i) was enrolled in Year 4 of the Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery Program;
 - (ii) achieved three or more higher level performance (HLP) results of four designated assessments (research project, end year 2, end year 3, and end of semester 1 in year 4); and
 - (iii) enhanced the Medical School experience and contributed to the broader community during their studies.
4. Candidates for the prize (those students who have achieved three or more HLP results at end of Semester 1 Year 4) will be invited to submit a 500 word overview of their enhancement of the medical school experience and their contribution to the broader community during their studies.
5. The Selection Committee will review submissions.
6. The Selection Committee shall be chaired by the Dean and include the Associate Dean School of Clinical Medicine, Director Medical Education Unit, the respective year co-ordinators for that cohort and the Associate Dean Rural Clinical School.
7. The prize may be shared.
8. If, in any year, no student is assessed by the Dean of the Medical School acting on the advice of the Selection Committee, as sufficiently outstanding the prize shall not be awarded in that year.

The Graham Wilkinson bequest honours the memory of Mr Graham Wilkinson. The Graham Wilkinson Prize was first established as a prize of the University of Sydney's Canberra Clinical School in 1995 donated by Graham and Muriel Wilkinson of Red Hill in the ACT. Mr and Mrs Wilkinson indicated their wish to establish a prize for the student performance in the final year of the Medical Program. Mr Wilkinson passed away in October 1996, but his memory will endure in the medical student prize which has now been transferred to the ANU Medical School and is awarded for excellence in medical studies and is aimed at promoting excellence in all endeavours amongst medical students. From 2007 this prize will be awarded to the student who demonstrates outstanding performance over the medical program (MBBS).
