

THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF HEALTH AND MEDECINE HONOURS PSYCHOLOGY THESIS PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be three prizes each of \$200 for award each year which shall be known as the Honours Psychology Thesis Prize.
- 2. The prizes shall be awarded to the students who, in that year
 - (i) was enrolled in a program leading to the award of a degree of Bachelor with Honours in the ANU College of Health and Medicine
 - (ii) was enrolled in Psychology IV Honours (PSYC4005); and
 - (iii) achieved the best results, as shown by the award of the three highest marks for an Honours thesis in Psychology.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize in any year if:
 - (i) the student has previously been awarded the prize;
 - (ii) the student is making a second of subsequent attempt at the course; or
 - (iii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which, is in the opinion of the Associate Dean (Education) substantially similar to the content of the course for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 4. If, in any year, more than three students equally merit the award of the prize, the prizes awarded for that year shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any year, no students achieve results that, in the opinion of the Associate Dean (Education), justifying on or more of the prizes, then that prize of prizes shall not be awarded for that year.
