## JACOBS MEDAL FOR OUTSTANDING FIELD STUDIES IN FORESTRY

## Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize for award each year which shall be known as the Jacobs Medal for Outstanding Field Studies in Forestry. The prize shall take the form of a medal.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year:
  - (i) completed the final year in a program leading to the award of a degree of Bachelor in the ANU College of Science; and
  - (ii) was deemed to have achieved the most outstanding performance in forestry-related field studies including field practical exercises throughout the program.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize in any year if:
  - (i) the student is making a second or subsequent attempt at any of the relevant courses; or
  - (ii) the student has previously pursued a program of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which is, in the opinion of the Associate Dean (Education), substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 4. If, in any year, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, a medal shall be awarded to each.
- 6. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Associate Dean (Education), justify awarding the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
