Jagadishwar Mahanty Prize

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize for award each year which shall be known as the Jagadishwar Mahanty Prize.
- 2. The value of the prize may vary from year to year and will be determined by the Selection Committee at the time of award.
- 3. The prize shall be awarded to the student who:
 - (i) was admitted to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy of the University in the period from 1 July of the previous year to 30 June of the current calendar year; and
 - (ii) submitted the most outstanding thesis in the Research School of Physics and Engineering in the ANU College of Science.
- 4. The Selection Committee shall be appointed by the Director of the Research School of Physics and Engineering or nominee.
- 5. In making the recommendation, the Selection Committee will prepare a short list based on the examiner's reports and will consider statements of support from supervisors of the short-listed theses.
- 6. If, in any year, in the opinion of the Associate Dean (Education) on the advice of the Director of the Research School of Physics and Engineering, one or more theses equally merit the award of the prize, each author shall receive a prize of equal value.
- 7. If, in any year, no thesis, in the opinion of the Associate Dean (Education) on the advice of the Director of the Research School of Physics and Engineering, justifies the award of the prize, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
