LOUIS SZABO "SILVER PROBE" PRIZE

Terms and Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize for award each year which shall be known as the ANU Medical School Louis Szabo "Silver Probe" Prize.
- 2. The value of the prize is \$500.00.
- 3. The prize shall be awarded each year to the student who, in that year was:
 - a. enrolled in Year Four of the Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery Program;
 - b. identified by a Selection Committee of three members, as showing outstanding and comprehensive knowledge as a tutor/demonstrator of Anatomy; and
 - c. assessed as the best candidate in a *viva voce* examination taken by the tutor/ demonstrator.
- 4. Nominations will be made through a 300 word recommendation from staff who have responsibilities for the teaching of anatomy in the MBBS program. Nominations will be made directly to the Professor of Anatomy, and will close at the conclusion of the final semester of Year 4.
- 5. The members of the Selection Committee shall be appointed by the Dean from the members of the Anatomy teaching staff, ANU Medical School and shall include the Professor of Anatomy.
- 6. Selection of the awardee will be made within 4 weeks from the close of nominations.
- 7. The prize shall not be shared.
- 8. If, in any year, no candidate is assessed by the Dean of the Medical School acting on the advice of the Selection Committee, as sufficiently outstanding and reflecting comprehensive knowledge of Anatomy, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.

The prize is a gift from Mr. Louis Szabó, founding member of ANU Medical School Anatomy Laboratory. The Louis Szabo "Silver Probe" Prize has been developed in order to promote knowledge of and interest in Anatomy as part of the basic science in medicine.
