MARGARET SMILES ACCOMPANIMENT PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of \$2,000 for award each year which shall be known as the Margaret Smiles Accompaniment Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded each year to the student who, in that year:
 - (i) was enrolled in a program leading to the award of a degree offered by the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences;
 - (ii) competed in the Margaret Smiles Accompaniment Competition; and
 - (iii) was, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences acting on the advice of the Judging Panel, considered the most deserving piano accompaniment student.
- 3. The prize will be awarded on the recommendation of a Judging Panel appointed by the Head of the School of Music.
- 4. If, in any year, two or more students merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any year, no student performs at a level that, in the opinion the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences, acting on the advice of the Judging Panel justifies awarding the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
