Master of Arts (International Relations) Prize

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of a \$100.00 book voucher for award for each graduating class which shall be known as the Graduate Studies in International Affairs Master of Arts (International Relations) Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded in each graduating class to the student who:
 - (i) completed the program leading to the award of a degree of Master of Arts (International Relations) in the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific; and
 - (ii) achieved the highest overall aggregate result for the Master of Arts (International Relations).
- 3. If, in any graduating class, two or more students achieve the same top mark, the prize awarded for that graduating class shall be divided equally between them.
- 4. If, in any graduating class, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, justify awarding the prize for that graduating class, the prize shall not be awarded for that graduating class.
