Conditions of Award

MASTER OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION PRIZE

- 1. There shall be a prize of \$200 for award each graduating class (generally each semester) which shall be known as the Master of Public Administration Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student in that graduating class, who:
 - (i) completed the requirements for admission to the degree of Master of Public Administration; and
 - (ii) achieved the best overall aggregate results in this degree.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if:
 - (i) the student has made a second or subsequent attempt at any course in the Master degree; or
 - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which is, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 4. If, in any graduating class, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded for that graduating class shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any graduating class, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, justify the award of the prize, the prize shall not be awarded.
