

THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF HEALTH AND MEDICINE MICHAEL L COOK PRIZE FOR SCIENTIFIC WRITING IN PSYCHOLOGY

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of \$100 for award each year which shall be known as the Michael L Cook Prize for Scientific Writing in Psychology.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded each year to the student who, in that year:
 - (i) was enrolled in a program leading to the award of a degree of Bachelor,
 - (ii) achieved the best results in that year in a laboratory report or assignment in a course within the PSYC1000 range of courses, as assessed by a moderating panel assembled by the Head of the Department of Psychology.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if the student is making a second or subsequent attempt at the course of which the laboratory report or assignment was a component.
- 4. If, in any year, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded for that year shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Associate Dean (Education) on the advice of the moderating panel, justify awarding the prize, the prize shall not be awarded for that year.
