RAYMOND APTHORPE GRADUATE DIPLOMA PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of a \$100 book voucher for award each year, which shall be known as the Raymond Apthorpe Graduate Diploma Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year:
 - (i) successfully completed the requirements for the award of the Graduate Diploma in Public Administration; and
 - (ii) in the opinion of the Dean, ANU College of Asia and the Pacific achieved the best overall aggregate results in the Diploma.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if:
 - (i) the student has made a second or subsequent attempt at any course in the Diploma; or
 - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which is, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 4. If, in any year, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean, ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, justify the award of the prize, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
