

THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF ASIA AND THE PACIFIC RAYMOND APTHORPE MASTER DEGREE PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of a \$100 awarded each year, which shall be known as the Raymond Apthorpe Master Degree Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year:
 - (i) successfully completed the requirements for admission to the degree of Master of Public Policy specialising in Development Policy; and
 - (ii) in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, achieved the best overall aggregate results in this degree.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if:
 - (i) the student has made a second or subsequent attempt at any course in the degree; or
 - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which is, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 4. If, in any year, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, justify the award of the prize, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
