REGINALD DE BRAY PRIZE FOR FIRST YEAR LINGUISTICS

Conditions of Award

1. There shall be a prize of \$250 for award each year which shall be known as the Reginald de Bray Prize for First Year Linguistics.
2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, that year was enrolled in the course Introduction to Linguistics (LING1001) and achieved the highest mark in the course.
3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if:
 - (i) the student is making a second or subsequent attempt at the course; or
 - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which, is in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences, substantially similar to the content of the course for which the prize is to be awarded.
4. If, in any year, two or more students achieve the same top mark, the prize money shall be divided equally between them.
5. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences, justify awarding the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
