TIRI TIRI PRIZE

Conditions of Award

- 1. There shall be a prize of a \$100 awarded in respect of each graduating class (generally each semester), which shall be known as the Tiri Tiri Prize.
- 2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who in that graduating class:
 - successfully completed the requirements for admission to the degree of Master of Environmental Management and Development; and
 - (ii) in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, was the most outstanding Master degree student, achieving the highest academic excellence in the degree, including the best overall aggregate results.
- 3. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize if:
 - (i) the student has made a second or subsequent attempt at any course in the Master degree program; or
 - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, is substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 4. If, in any graduating class, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded in respect of that graduating class shall be divided equally between them.
- 5. If, in any graduating class, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, justify awarding the prize, the prize shall not be awarded in respect of that graduating class.
